

# Prayer Guide for Kingdom Builders 2026

## Week 1 | What is God calling His people to?

### Meditation 1

*Isaiah 49:6b - I will make you as a light for the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth."*

It's always been God's heart to reach all of His children with His truth. He's put the church in the unique position to be His hands and feet in the carrying out of that mission. What a beautiful and awesome responsibility!

#### Reflection Questions:

1. In your own words, why does God describe the church as a "light for the nations"?
2. What could it look like when salvation reaches "the end of the earth"?

### Meditation 2

*Matthew 24:14 - And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.*

God won't give up until everyone has heard of His great rescue plan! Steve Richardson of Pioneers writes, "The Great Commission is the most ambitious undertaking in the history of the world. It involves hundreds of millions of people and spans thousands of years. It encompasses a vast number of languages, cultures and locations."

#### Reflection Questions:

1. How does this passage (Matthew 24:14) make you feel? Bold? Intimidated? Excited?
2. What do you think the "Gospel of the Kingdom" is?

### Meditation 3

*Psalms 67:1-2 - May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine on us—so that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations.*

We're all on a journey toward becoming more like Jesus. This change should be evident in every aspect of our lives from work to home, from our private to public lives, from our habits and the way we spend our time to our bank accounts.

#### Reflection Questions:

1. How should the church spend its time and money differently than the world does?
2. In Psalm 67, David asks to be blessed so that God's ways may be known. Do you feel like God blesses you for the same reason?

## Week 2 | What is God calling LIFEChurch to?

### Meditation 1

*Romans 10:14 - How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?*

Here at LIFEChurch, we join God in His plan to reach all people with the truth of the Gospel. Kingdom Builders specifically is a way for us to join Him in reaching some of the least reached places on earth, places where no believers currently live, where the Bible is not available in the spoken language, where people have never heard the name of Jesus.

#### Reflection Questions:

1. How do you respond to the above paragraph?
2. What are one or two things that stick out to you from Romans 10:14?

### Meditation 2

*Romans 10:15 - And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"*

Kingdom Builders has a three-fold focus - global impact, local impact and future leaders. In this way, we hope to see the good news come here at home, far away in places we'll probably never see, and in the generations that come after us.

#### Reflection Questions:

1. Briefly define for yourself the 3 focuses of Kingdom Builders - global, local, and future.
2. Which one of the three categories speaks to you the most?

### Meditation 3

*John 6:44 - "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up on the last day."*

"Nothing on earth has greater potential to change lives and carry out His kingdom work in your community, than your local church. There's nothing like the local church when it's working right. Its beauty is indescribable. Its power is breathtaking. Its potential is unlimited. No other organization on earth is like the church. Nothing even comes close."

#### Reflection Questions:

1. What do you think is the role of the local church in the Great Commission?
2. How do you see LIFEChurch participating in the Great Commission?

## **Week 3 | What is God calling you to?**

### **Meditation 1**

*2 Corinthians 9:11 - You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.*

God knew that His people, both individually and collectively, both now and throughout history, would struggle with generosity and greed. That's why He talks about it so much. If you are or ever have struggled in this area, you're not alone. In fact, you're in good company.

#### **Reflection Questions:**

1. What does the word 'generosity' mean to you?
2. In what areas of your life do you feel God is calling you to be more generous (time, money, talents etc.)?

### **Meditation 2**

*2 Corinthians 9:13 - Because of the service by which you have proved yourselves, others will praise God for the obedience that accompanies your confession of the gospel of Christ, and for your generosity in sharing with them and with everyone else.*

Sometimes it's hard for us to believe that God will really use us or that our time, money, and talents could really make a difference for the Kingdom, but it's true. God uses the regular, every day Jesus follower to change the lives of others. Max Lucado says, "The people who make a difference are not the ones with the credentials but the ones with the concern."

#### **Reflection Questions:**

1. Do you believe God will use what He has given you for His Kingdom?
2. Ask God what He's calling you to with regard to Kingdom Builders 2025. What do you think He's saying?

### **Meditation 3**

*2 Corinthians 9:7 - Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.*

Throughout this month, you've heard a lot about what God has done and is doing through LIFEChurch, through Kingdom Builders, and our partners all over the world. You've heard our plans for 2025 and what the needs and goals are. Now is the moment to decide how God is calling you to be involved. We are praying for you as you pray about and for Kingdom Builders 2025.

#### **Reflection Questions:**

1. Are you able to give joyfully and cheerfully or do you feel reluctant?
2. Is God giving you a specific number, percentage or goal He's calling you to this year with regard to Kingdom Builders? What commitment are you making toward Kingdom Builders 2025?
