

A Special Invitation to 21 Days of Prayer

Church, I can't even begin to describe how excited I am for these next 21 days. This is a "lift the sails" moment—we are poised and ready for the Holy Spirit to do what only He can do. I believe that God is moving us and awakening something fresh in your life, in your family, and in our church. As we spend these next 21 days in focused prayer, I know that Heaven will lean in, we will see more clearly, and **GOD WILL MOVE!**

We believe in the power of prayer. The apostle Paul tells us, "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything." This is Paul's affirmation of the power of prayer. God understands the times we are living in. He is not surprised by our political situation, our economic struggles, or our family concerns. **HE HOLDS OUR FUTURE!** And that is good news.

Over these 21 days, you'll engage with a daily topic, a verse, and a prayer specifically crafted to lead you into a deeper, richer connection with God. God's Word is our anchor—it builds faith, dispels fear, and fills our hearts with truth and courage. As you pray through His promises, you will begin to experience anxiety loosening its grip, supernatural peace rising within you, and your spirit growing stronger.

A FEW TIPS AS YOU PRIORITIZE PRAYER OVER THESE NEXT 21 DAYS...

My hope is that this guide will ignite something new in your prayer life—a fresh hunger for God, a renewed consistency in worship and prayer, and a deeper joy in meeting with Him. Prayer isn't an obligation; it's an invitation. It's not a chore; it's a privilege. We don't "have to"—we get to come before the God who loves us and listens to us.

And here's what you'll discover when you pray—before the day begins, before the decisions are made, before the worry sets in:

- His presence becomes undeniable as you navigate your day.
- His peace becomes unshakable as you face challenges.
- His voice becomes unmistakable in the midst of all the static in our world.

So I encourage you to take these next 21 days as an opportunity to deepen your faith and reset your heart. When we pray, God moves.

I love you, LIFE church family. I'm praying with you, believing with you, and expecting God to do more than we can ask or imagine in these next 21 days. Let's lift the sails and catch the wind!

Prayer is most effective when it isn't something we do every now and then, but when it's a lifestyle, we constantly cultivate our prayer life. To understand how to have a lifestyle of prayer, we can look at the example Jesus gave during His life on earth.

FIND A TIME: PRIORITIZE IT

Jesus got up early in the morning to spend time with His Heavenly Father. Make a daily appointment with God - whether it's first thing in the morning, at lunch, or in the evening - and faithfully keep it.

FIND A PLACE: PROTECT IT

Jesus had a specific place He went to pray. Having a designated place to pray helps us remove distractions and frees us to worship and pray out loud.

FIND A PLAN: PRACTICE IT

When Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, He gave them a prayer outline. We call it "The Lord's Prayer." Our desire is for this resource to be a guide for your time with God. As we pray every day, consider incorporating some worship music, or additional time to read the Bible or journal. Not everyone's approach will look the same, but it does help to have a plan for connecting regularly with God!

DAY
1

SURRENDER

He must become greater and greater, and I must become less and less.

John 3:30 NLT

PRAYER

God, as I set aside these next 21 days to seek You, I come with a heart fully surrendered. Today, I lay down my plans, my ambitions, and my own ways, asking that Your will be done in every part of my life. I make room for You—room to move, to speak, to heal, to reveal, and to lead.

Let there be more of You and less of me. As I draw near, deepen my faith and let me experience Your presence in a way I never have before. I come with expectation for all You will do.

DAY 2

PEACE



*I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart.
And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give.
So don't be troubled or afraid.*

John 14:27 NLT

PRAYER

Father, today I acknowledge Your presence and embrace the gift of Your peace. Help me recognize the moments when I look for peace apart from You, knowing that nothing the world offers can satisfy my soul. Only You give the peace that lasts.

Even when I face things I cannot understand, I thank You for a peace that surpasses all understanding. I praise You for Your supernatural peace, and I receive it now. Let Your peace guard my heart and my mind.

DAY 3

FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS



You can develop a healthy, robust community that lives right with God and enjoy its results only if you do the hard work of getting along with each other, treating each other with dignity and honor.

James 3:18 MSG

PRAYER

Lord, I come to You asking for supernatural health in every relationship within my family. I know true unity takes work, and I am willing to do my part. Show me where I need to lay myself aside and choose love, grace, forgiveness, and selflessness.

Help me see each member of my family the way You see them, believing the best and honoring them in both my words and actions.

I pray for restoration and healing wherever it's needed. Teach us to release what doesn't matter and to hold tightly to what truly does. Thank You for leading and guiding me as I entrust my family to You. I believe the best is yet to come.

DAY 4

WORRY

Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life.

Philippians 4:6-7 MSG

PRAYER

Father, today I surrender every worry and every care into Your hands. I choose to turn my list of worries into my list of prayers. When my mind feels overwhelmed or out of control, help me renew it with Your Word. In Jesus' mighty Name, I command anything that is not from You to leave. I declare that I have a sound, steady, and healthy mind.

I lay down all worry, every form of anxiety—both physical and mental—and every attempt to control what was never mine to control. I release it all to You. (Tell Him the things you are laying down now.)

Lord, I need You and the peace that surpasses all understanding. Even when everything around me feels uncertain, let Your peace rule in my heart and be evident in my life. As I lift my praise to You, dissolve every fear and every anxious thought. I place all my concerns before You and make You the center of my mind and my focus.

DAY 5

ALL WILL KNOW JESUS

For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.

Luke 19:10 NLT

PRAYER

Lord, I know Your heart is that every person would come to salvation and that none would be lost without You. Today I lift _____ before You—every person in my life who needs to come to know Jesus. I ask that You continue drawing them to Yourself through Your kindness, just as Your Word promises. You pursue every heart, and I pray You would keep pursuing _____ with Your love and grace.

Use me as an extension of Your love in their lives. Holy Spirit, reveal to them their need for a Savior—a leader and forgiver. Awaken their spirit and create in them a deep thirst for You and for what only You can give. Open their ears to hear Your voice and soften their heart to respond.

Thank You that You are a God of transformation, redemption, and life-change.

DAY 6

FREEDOM

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

PRAYER

God, I know there are many things in this world that try to pull me away from the life You've called me to live. You sent Your Son, Jesus, to die on the cross and rise from the dead—erasing the power of sin for all mankind, including me. Because of His sacrifice, I walk in new life and true freedom.

Give me strength to overcome every temptation and to stand firm against sin. I thank You that nothing on this earth is greater or more powerful than the Name of Jesus. His victory on the cross is my victory today.

Help me desire You above anything and anyone else. Thank You, God, for the freedom You've given me.

DAY 7

GOVERNMENT

I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. This is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

1 Timothy 2:1-4 NLT

PRAYER

God, today I lift up our government to You. I pray for Your blessing over every leader, their households, and their families. I ask that those in authority would surrender to Your guidance and allow Your wisdom to shape every decision they make.

Let peace and healing come upon our nation. Let truth rise and prevail. Move in ways far beyond what we could ask, dream, or imagine—because that is who You are. Work all things together for good for those who love You.

I pray that every leader in authority would turn their heart toward You. Let Your Name be known throughout our nation, and let Your supernatural work transform us as we become desperate for more of You.

DAY
8

HEALTH

DAY
9

WISDOM FOR LEADERS

PRAYER

These days are incredibly challenging, yet Your Word promises that if we lack wisdom and ask, You will give it generously. So I ask boldly—pour out Your wisdom over every leader in my life.

Give them what they need to navigate this season with grace, clarity, intention, and God-inspired ideas. Let their decisions be marked by compassion, wisdom, and care for the people they lead. Thank You for these leaders. Strengthen them with Your truth and encourage their hearts. Remind them that You have equipped them for the task before them. Nothing is too difficult for You, and I believe You are filling them with supernatural wisdom right now.

God, I am so grateful for Your unfailing and unchanging character. You are trustworthy and faithful—this is who You are. Thank You that I can rely on Your promises and rest in Your presence. Today I lay every burden at Your feet. Thank You for working all things together for my good.

When disappointment or discouragement tries to pull me down, let hope rise and anchor my soul. Holy Spirit, remind me again and again that my hope in You is firm and unwavering. I choose to hold tightly to the hope You've given me today, and I refuse to let go.

DAY
20

BOLDNESS FOR BELIEVERS

Therefore, since we have such a hope, we are very bold.

PRAYER

DAY
21

PRAYER

Father, in Jesus' Name, I am believing for a breakthrough in _____ (be specific about what you need). I stand on Your Word that declares You are doing something new and that You will make a pathway through every hardship.

I declare that You have plans to bless me, and I believe that whatever the enemy intended for evil, You will turn for good. Give me fresh vision for what lies ahead and fill me with hope for the future. I know You are a miracle-working God, and nothing is impossible for You.

In Jesus' Name, Amen!

ADDITIONAL PRAYER & STUDY MODELS

We believe God wants a living, vital relationship with you; one that will inform every part of your life. We want each person to learn how to listen to God—to truly hear Him speak—and live life based on what He speaks.

To hear God speak we need to make room for Him in our lives every day—not just Sundays. To help each of us do that, we encourage a daily time of Bible reading and prayer. If you do not already have a way to do that, we recommend a devotional process called **SOAP**. **SOAP** is an acronym for **Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer**. This is particularly powerful when you write down what you see and hear in a journal or notebook.

Scripture:

Each day we recommend that you read a chapter of the Bible. You might choose to start with John or another book in the New Testament. Feel free to ask a leader, or someone else you know for their advice. YouVersion.com has loads of reading plans and will help you keep track of your pace and progress.

Observation:

As you read the Bible, listen for what God is saying to you. The Bible is alive, it is active, it is powerful (Hebrews 4:12, James 1:21). God will speak to you as you read. He will show you something. He may reveal something about Himself or about you. You may see something you have never seen before. You may have a question – write it down.

Application:

Now decide what your observation(s) mean for your life—it could be for today, or the future. You may need to deal with something from your past. You may feel strengthened or encouraged by what you read. It may change your perspective on a situation you face. You will be surprised what application you see as you simply write it down.

Prayer:

After reading the Scripture and noting your observation(s), pray about what you have experienced. Prayer is simply talking with God. It is a personal conversation. You may have discovered something you need to pray on a regular basis for a while, or a simple request for the immediate situations you face in life. As you pray, pause for a few moments. Is God speaking to you? Are you feeling prompted to do something? Is there something being imparted – a direction, courage, confidence?

TOPICAL PRAYER INDEX

When we pray, we shift our focus from our own limitations to God's power and limitless resources. Our heavenly Father is greater than any situation we will ever face—no matter how painful, frightening, or uncertain it feels in the moment. Whatever we're walking through, we can anchor ourselves in God's Word. Find a verse that speaks to your situation and trust God with the outcome. Pray His promises and rely on His power to be revealed.

The Word of God is one of the greatest tools we've been given to build a dynamic, faith-filled prayer life. Use the scriptures below as a guide to pray and engage in conversation with God.

Here's an example prayer based on Psalm 23:

Lord, thank You for being my Shepherd and guiding me. With You, I have everything I need. Even when I walk through darkness, I will not be afraid, because You are with me. Thank You for giving me peace, directing my steps, and filling my life with Your unfailing love. Amen.

ASSURANCE:

The LORD is my Shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters, He refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for His Name's sake. Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff,

they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely Your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

PSALM 23 NIV

ANXIETY:

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7 NIV

Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

COMFORT:
